I am requesting funding for Torrey Town Sand Creek Bridge Replacement, Torrey Town, Utah, 2<sup>nd</sup> District in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is Torrey Town, located at 75 East 100 North, Torrey, UT 84775. The funding would be used to replace the bridge with an updated structure capable of supporting the hydraulic, width, and weight criteria of modern codes. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it addresses the current bridge which is a major safety concern that directly impacts the safety of all residents and visitors using the bridge. The current bridge cannot withstand high water flows, is not constructed according to modern engineering methods used to accommodate the heavier loads for a frequently used road, and is not wide enough to accommodate fire apparatus vehicles. This project will help ensure access for residents and visitors and ensure they are not stuck without assistance in the event of a flood or fire.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C.5305(a)(1), 5305(a)(2), 5305(a)(4), and/or 5305(a)(5).
