I am requesting funding for Cedar Point Transmission Pipeline project, Apple Valley, Utah, 2nd District in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is Big Plains Water Special Service District located at 1777 N Meadowlark Dr. Apple Valley, UT 84737. The funding would be used to add an interconnecting water service line from Utah water system number 27069 (Apple Valley system) to Utah water system number 27089 (Cedar Point system). The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will provide safe drinking water in areas of the town that are now struggling to keep up with demand and are testing high in Manganese and Radium. This improvement will allow water to flow from a cleaner, more reliable source.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
