SECTION 1. INCLUSION OF EYEGLASS LENS FITTINGS IN
 MEDICAL SERVICES AUTHORIZED TO BE FUR NISHED UNDER VETERANS COMMUNITY
 CARE PROGRAM; REPORT.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subparagraph (C) of paragraph
6 (6) of section 1701 of title 38, United States Code, is
7 amended by inserting "services, fittings for eyeglass
8 lenses," after "Optometric".

9 (b) REGULATIONS.—The Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall establish policies and procedures and prescribe 10 11 regulations to carry out the amendment made by subsection (a). Under such regulations, the Secretary shall 12 13 ensure that a veteran eligible to receive medical services from a non-Department of Veterans Affairs provider 14 under section 1703 of title 38, United States Code, can 15 16 schedule an appointment for a fitting for eyeglass lenses at such a provider in geographic proximity to the veteran. 17 18 (c) REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after the date 19 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall submit

- 20 to Congress a report that includes—
- (1) a statement of the status of the implemen-tation of the amendment made by subsection (a);
- 23 (2) a summary of any challenges faced with re-24 spect to such implementation;
- 25 (3) a strategy to mitigate such challenges, if26 applicable; and

(4) an assessment of the benefits for veterans
 resulting from such amendment.
